Lunch Bunch offers our students opportunities for additional socialization through mealtime, extended activities, and play. We provide a safe, nurturing place where the children can eat lunch with their peers, while learning to manage and clean up their own space, with the bonus of added time to socialize and play with their friends.

With the company of our supportive teachers, Lunch Bunch kiddos can acclimate to a longer school day, can make mistakes (such as spills) and be helped to fix them, and can gain confidence and independence.

Lunch Time is very fast in elementary school and here at Hope we believe in providing Lunch Bunch as an opportunity for our students to practice the "soft skills" needed for kindergarten success.


PARENTING WITH CONSCIOUS DISCIPLINE SESSIONS COMING SOON!

This Month's Game Changer: The D.N.A. Process

This process helps us move toward offering conscious empathy and coaching children from the lower centers to the higher centers of their brains in order to solve problems effectively. As we scaffold this process during times of upset, we provide children with an outside voice that will ultimately contribute to a healthy self-regulatory voice.

The first five years are when the brain grows faster than any other time in life.



Did you know that reading books with your young child does more than help them learn words and develop language skills? *\arrow \lefter \lefter \righter \righter \righter \righter \righter \righter \righter \righter \rightarrow \right*

It also helps them learn to pay attention, set goals and control themselves. These important life skills start to develop in early childhood.

Read with your child every day and make sure to not just recite the words but also point and name things on the pages. It's this type of interaction that will help your little one's brain develop. <a>

Researchers call it the Goldilocks effect. Reading a storybook with pictures is "just right" because it sparks more brain activity in kids than reading a book without pictures or watching a cartoon.

We are saving up for a toddler playground structure. Any proceeds from these two fundraisers will go towards that goal.




